

MapLink Pro Data Preparation Training Course

Through a mixture of presentations, demonstrations and hands-on exercises, this course explains how MapLink Studio can produce maps specifically tuned to your application environment.

The course lasts for two days though this can be extended with additional modules for more advanced training in specialized areas. Courses are normally restricted to a maximum of four people, though larger groups can be accommodated on request.

Who will benefit?

This course is aimed at users who will be using MapLink Studio to prepare and process data for their MapLink application.

Participants must have basic computer literacy and a general understanding of mapping principles. A working knowledge of English is also required.

Objectives

By the end of this course you should have an understanding of the following in relation to MapLink:

- How MapLink maps are structured
- Key concepts such as map coordinate systems
- How to build multi-layer, multi-format maps and terrain databases
- The current significant map formats related to MapLink
- How to prepare map processing templates
- Performance issues in relation to maps
